Extension> While on internship, our students are taught to work with everyone, regardless of religious background. In their assigned communities they want to work and improve the peasants' life.



Duchity> our newest endeavor in the mountains. Here we started working with the peasants since the hurricane in Oct 16. We have avocados, bananas, and yam roots growing. The coffee nursery is ready for distribution. We praise God for the fertile soil and the opportunity to minister to this poor area that was hit the hardest.



CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS: Since beginning of August we began construction of the new store/pharmacy building which will also include the copy center and the marketing office. We had used the chemistry lab temporarily but the lab will be needed for fall classes. This building is still necessary in order to comply with the City's plan enlarging the road. We are taking advantage of school vacation to move forward with the building, including 2 classrooms. The foreman understands the urgency and he is pushing his team to move quickly. Please pray for God's provision, wisdom and safety.



Urgent prayer request: Since one year the unrest had started in order to have the president resign. The protests grew more and more and now the country is almost completely on a stand-still since over 1 month. The capital and our town are becoming ghost towns! Pray for protection of our families and students. We pray that there will be a solution found soon.

LAND ISSUES: Sad to say there is still no solution in sight to regain the occupied land. We continue to hope and pray!
DORIS is in Germany with a new knee! Spent 4 weeks at a rehab clinic and started physical therapy. It's going well but I still have a long road ahead of me. I am so thankful to the Lord for His help.

DANIEL finished his summer classes and passed them all! Thank God for that. We are proud of him.

MANGUEL wants to be a butcher; he will do an internship in Germany first to see if this is what he really wants to do.
